

# Hope

## **OUTCOME:**

10.1 – What keeps us going?

- Demonstrates an understanding of hope and its role in Christian living
  - Explores their understanding of hope
  - Creates prayers of hope for themselves and others
  - Using selected scripture passages, explores the meaning of “Christian Hope”
  - Applies the Christian notion of hope to their everyday lives

## **ASSIGNMENT:**

Step 1: Brainstorm about hope:

- How is the hope shown in the Nativity Story similar to that shown by Tom Hank’s character in Castaway?
- What does hope mean to you? How can hope help you in your everyday lives?
- How has hope impacted your life or someone close to you? How can it give you strength to carry on?
- Can hope mean something different to different people? In which ways?

Step 2: You will be creating an Animoto about hope in partners. Your Animoto must include pictures and words that relate to hope. It can also include videos if you wish. It must also be set to a song that has to do with hope.

You must have:

- at least 10 pictures that you have taken yourself (remember to ask people if it is alright that you use their picture)
- 2 scripture passages about hope included somewhere in your project
- a song about hope to be the background information
